Tord Kjellstrom is a Visiting Fellow and Professor from the National Centre for Epidemiology and Population Health, at The Australian National University in Canberra. He is also the Director of the Health and Environmental International Trust in New Zealand, and was an epidemiologist for the World Health Organization for 12 years. Dr. Kjellstrom has worked for almost 40 years as a teacher and researcher in epidemiology, environmental health, and occupational health, and has published more than 300 reports on public health.

Recent reports by Dr. Kjellstrom work includes “Workplace heat stress and health- an increasing challenge for low and middle income countries during climate change,” and “Global climate change and health- a new theme for research in environmental medicine.”
