He is a leading expert in conditions that influence the health and safety of migrant Hispanic farmworkers and helped establish the Center for Agricultural Research, Education and Disease and Injury Prevention through the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health. His research focuses on job-related hazards such as pesticide poisoning; skin disease and respiratory illnesses in seasonal agricultural workers; muscle strain injuries, and most recently, sexual harassment of women farmworkers.
