- I. **Brief project description and its current status** (500 words for a scientific audience).
 - a. Emphasis should be on the project's agricultural health and safety components.
 - b. Include a list of any presentations given, publications, and/or funding sought/received.

- II. **Blog post** (500 words for a lay audience/general public).
 - a. Blog posts can focus on the research project or reflect on experiences as a graduate student. Writing prompts that may be used include (but are not limited to):
 - i. What agricultural health and safety problem are you trying to address through your research? Why is it important?
 - ii. What is the potential impact on improving health and safety by solving the problem?
 - iii. Describe your project and results to-date.
 - iv. What is the next step in your research?
