- I. **Brief project description and its current status** (500 words for a scientific audience).
 - a. Emphasis should be on the project's agricultural health and safety components.
 - b. Include a list of any presentations given, publications, and/or funding sought/received.
- II. **Blog post** (500 words for a lay audience/general public).
 - a. Blog posts can focus on the research project or reflect on experiences as a graduate student. Writing prompts that may be used include (but are not limited to):
 - i. How would you describe your research project to someone who isn't familiar with the field?
 - ii. What is your favorite part of conducting research? What is the hardest?
 - iii. How does your research relate to community efforts to improve agricultural health and safety?
